

## **STAY COMPLIANT** *Is an ELD Required in Your Idealease Rental Truck?*

## THERE ARE THREE EXEMPTIONS FROM ELD REQUIREMENTS FOR RENTAL TRUCKS:

- Driver renting a vehicle for eight days or less. (A copy of the FMCSA exemption letter must be attached to the rental agreement)
- 2 Driver currently using paper logs for no more than eight days during any rolling 30-day period. This includes both CDL and NON-CDL drivers who utilize the short-haul exceptions to the "grid log" requirement and maintain "time records" as long as they are able to meet the requirements of the exceptions 22 days out of a rolling 30 day period. If driver cannot meet the requirements or have to log more than eight days, an ELD is required.
- **3** Check with your Idealease Rental Manager to see if drivers are exempt from using an ELD for INTRAstate operations.

If none of the above exemptions apply, the Idealease Rental Manager will discuss the ELD options available to keep you in compliance.

## Know the FMCSA Regulation for Electronic Logging Devices (ELD)

By December 18, 2017, all carriers and drivers subject to the ELD regulation must use either an ELD or an **Automatic On-Board** Recording Device (AOBRD). An AOBRD is an electronic logging device that is connected to the engine ECM but may not meet all of the technical requirements of an ELD. AOBRDs put into use before December 18, 2017 may be used until December 16, 2019. Beginning on December 16, 2019, all carriers and drivers subject to the ELD requirement must use ELDs (not AOBRDs). ELDs must have the capability of either telematic data transfer or local transfer.
